Day 6 features the best of the Etowah's Native American fish weirs. It's a marathon paddle of 24 miles with plenty to see and enjoy.

Paddlers will paddle past bone-chilling Gillam Spring, around islands, over fish weirs, beyond the site of the Atlanta Steeplechase, and below a unique cave said to have been utilized by Native Americans. Further on, the rock features of Reynolds Bend provide nice swimming spots.

Paddle Georgia lead sponsor Georgia Power will provide an early morning tour of Plant Bowen for interested parties before the marathon paddle begins.
