A 17-mile paddle through time, Day 5 is perhaps the most eventful day of the trip. Paddlers will portage around the historic Thompson-Weinman Dam in Cartersville and on to the Etowah Indian Mounds where paddlers can visit the mounds and museum. Rangers will also be on hand building a dug out canoe with primitive tools, and paddlers can take part in the operation.

An optional tour of the historic Valley View Plantation Home is available as well. Before paddlers get to Euharlee and the town's historic covered bridge, paddlers will have paddled over no less than nine Native American fish weirs.
